R: Revision 3 to Water Department's Design Manual

The City of Oceanside's Water Utilities Department has recently made a few revisions and/or corrections to the Water, Sewer and Reclaimed Water Design and Construction Manual issued August 2005. These revisions were necessary to facilitate the ever continuing changes within the City of Oceanside and construction fields. Please remove the following sections from your current design manual and replace with the provided sections to ensure your Water Utilities Design manual is up-to-date.

- A Revision sheet has been included to notify you of the current Revision 3 changes in the design manual. This sheet should be located at the beginning of the design manual for reference.
- Section 2.0 Potable Water Systems has been revised and the entire section has been included to be replaced.
- Section 3.0 Sewer Systems has been revised and the entire section has been included to be replaced.
- Section 4.0 Reclaimed Water Systems has been revised and the entire section has been included to be replaced.
- General/Required Notes have been updated and the General and Water Notes have been included.
- The Appendix had a few revisions but for simplicity the entire section has been included in this packet for replacement of the previous Appendix section.
- Standard Drawings Water has revisions on sheets W-3, W-8, W-9, W-10, W-12, W-17, W-18, W-21, W-23 and W-25. These sheets have been included to be replaced.
- Standard Drawings Sewer has revisions on sheets S-1, S-1a, S-5, S-6 and S-8. These sheets have been included to be replaced.
- Standard Drawings Reclaimed Water has revisions on sheets RW-1, RW-1a, RW-3, RW-4, RW-6, RW-7, RW-12 and RW-21. These sheets have been included to be replaced.
