

About the Oceanside Public Library

The Oceanside Public Library, a department of the City of Oceanside, has 22 full-time and 28 part-time employees, and an operating budget of 4.4 million. The Library was founded in 1904, and today operates four facilities, including a beautiful 32,000 square foot Civic Center Library; a 12,000 square foot Mission Branch Library; the Oceanside READS Literacy Center and one Bookmobile.



The Library has a collection of over 270,000 items, online catalog, and is connected to the City of Oceanside's state-of-the art computer and communications network. As a high-profile, proactive player in the community, the Library offers a wide array of programs and services for all ages, including computer classes, concerts, cultural events and collaborative projects with local schools, museums and community agencies.

The Oceanside Public Library has a community-oriented service philosophy that strives for universal access, exemplary services, an outstanding collection of resources, dynamic community participation, and responsiveness to the public. A new Strategic Planning process is currently underway to guide the direction of the Library's development for the next 3 years.
