Photographer

Purpose: To assist Library staff in documenting daily activities and special events by taking quality photos.

Qualifications: Has own camera and experience taking photos of people and events, both indoors and outdoors. Possesses an excellent eye for the perfect photograph and basic computer skills. Comfortable interacting with people of all ages.

Responsibilities: Helping to document events and capturing the emotions of pictured subjects and activities. Photographing a minimum of two events per month. Assuring that photos are edited and saved as needed.

Training Provided: Guidelines will be shared and staff support will be provided.

Time Commitment: There are typically two to three special events per month, as well as daily and weekly reoccurring events, each lasting an average of one to two hours. Volunteer Photographers can sign up for as many, or as few as they would like, but a minimum of two events per month would be expected.

Length of Commitment: Minimum six month commitment requested.
